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To come to the learning platform. Select the unit that you want to start. After selecting a unit, you get brief information on the content of the unit.



The dialogues within the units are arranged by level A2 to B2. Therefore it is best to start with the dialogue 1. Click "Dialog 1". It opens a page where you can view the video directly. You also get information about the situation to the people and the place in the video.



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In the text below the video, some words are highlighted. If you move the mouse over these words, a window pops up, where you can find information on the word: Word Class, articles, plural form, definition or synonym phrases and the word in context.
